

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Introduction to this Directory

A cancer support centre provides emotional and practical support for people dealing with cancer. This includes those who have had a cancer diagnosis and their family and loved ones. Cancer support centres in Ireland are registered with the Charities Regulator. They are self-governed and self-funded.

This directory refers to the Alliance of Community Cancer Support Centres and Services as the Alliance. The Alliance is an initiative of the National Cancer Control Programme, which is part of the HSE. It sets the practice standards for community based cancer support services. Participation in the Alliance is voluntary.

The Alliance

Goals

- › Create a national support network where organisations can learn and work together.
- › Support the development of connections between cancer centres, hospitals, and community services.

Mission

- › Offer information, support, and learning opportunities to cancer support providers.
- › Make sure everyone affected by cancer gets the support they need.

Vision

An Ireland where anyone dealing with cancer gets the support they need in the right place at the right time. This support should be easy to access and delivered by qualified professionals.

Membership Types

There are two types of Alliance memberships:

Member

Member organisations provide community cancer support and meet the standards set by the Alliance. The NCCP published Best Practice Guidance sets out these standards. To become a member, an organisation must complete a self-assessment and peer review process. Organisations become full members after they've proven they meet the quality standards set by the Alliance. Members must also comply with the Charities Governance Code.



Associate Member

Associate member organisations provide community cancer support but have not gone through the evaluation process mentioned above. These organisations still align with the Alliance's goals and mission. They must comply with the Charities Governance Code.

The CLIMB programme is developed for children aged between 5-12 years. It aims to strengthen the children’s abilities to cope with the feelings associated with a parent’s cancer diagnosis and enables them to express their feelings using therapeutic art and play exercises.

Empower Menopause and Cancer Survivorship Programme is an in-person and online group programme for people impacted by menopause, as a result of cancer treatment. Participants watch pre-recorded modules by expert contributors who address the physical, emotional and psychological symptoms they have experienced. This is followed by an interactive peer support element where participants come together to share their experiences, feelings and knowledge, with the confidence that everything said is confidential. Each session is approximately 2 ½ hours and is free of charge.
