Find Womb Cancer Early

Around 500 people get womb cancer every year in Ireland. Womb cancer can happen at any age but it is more common in people aged over 50.

If womb cancer is found early, it's easier to treat and there's a better chance of cure and recovery.



Call your GP TODAY if you notice any of the following



Vaginal bleeding or spotting between periods



Vaginal bleeding or spotting after the menopause



Abnormal vaginal discharge. It may be bloodstained, pink, or smell unpleasant



A change in your bladder or bowel habit e.g. peeing or pooing more often than usual



Tummy pain or pain in your lower back, or pain during sex



Blood in your urine
